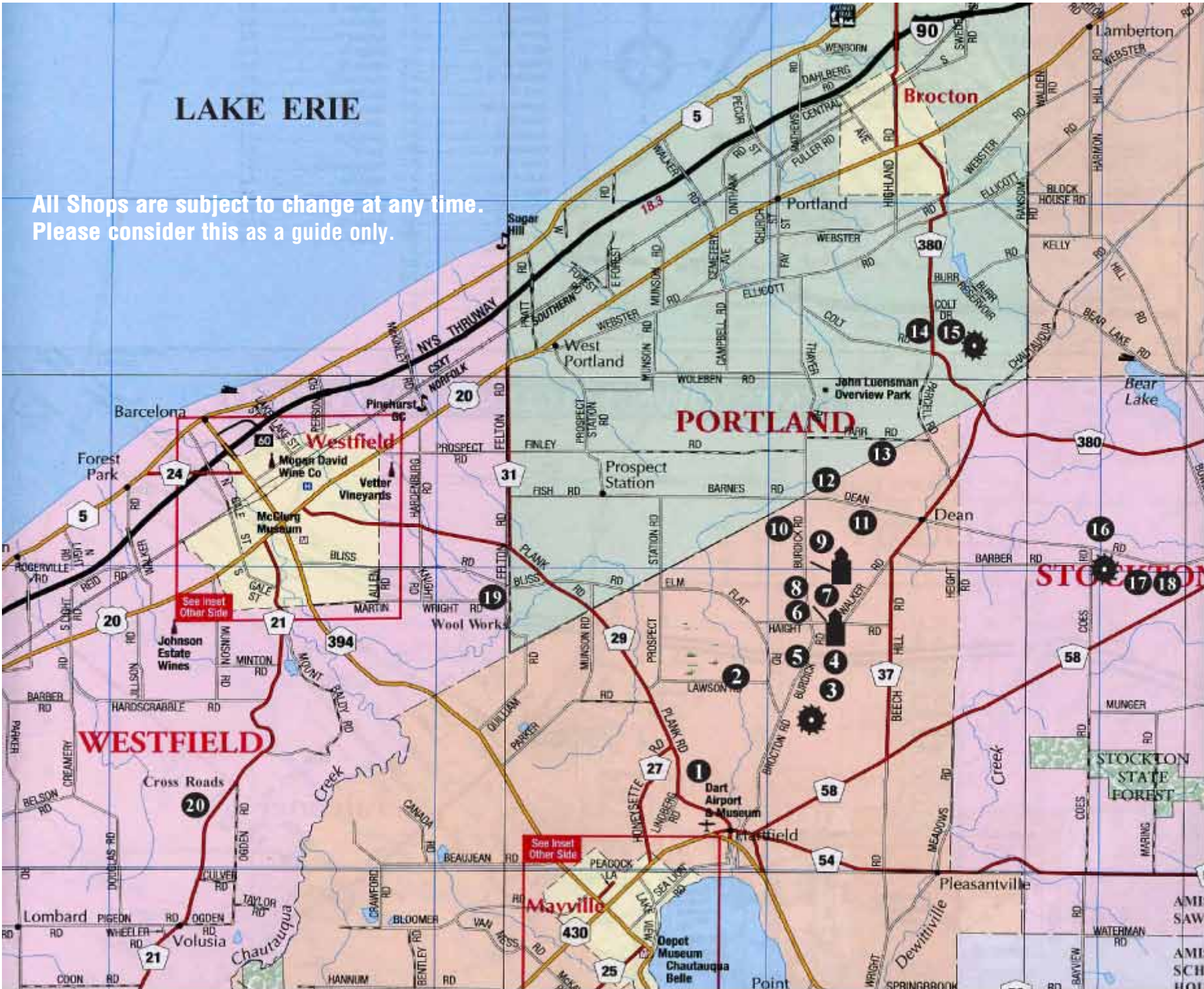

(Eastern Standard Time is followed all year round) You will also find that inventory levels will fluctuate according to seasonal demands (i.e.: planting & harvesting) Therefore, please be understanding of the variables while on your trip to the Amish Shops.
